TCCI calls for business assistance on power prices

Tasmanian Chamber of Commerce and Industry CEO, Michael Bailey, said the TCCI is very concerned about the impact of high electricity prices on Tasmanian businesses, especially during a period of rising costs and inflationary pressure.

“We recognise that care needs to be taken in intervening in the energy market, to ensure that we can protect consumers as well as providing confidence to investors.

“The TCCI is calling on the Government to consider carefully targeted assistance to businesses most exposed to price shocks, such as those looking to re-contract at this difficult time.”
